## On Target: Windows of Opportunity

There are windows of opportunity that people can take advantage of or miss out on. Most of us can look back on opportunities that we missed. Do you remember when you could have bought property for a song, but didn't recognize what a bargain it would have been or just didn't have the money to make the investment?

Our nation is going through some difficult times right now. The economy has tanked and tragically many good, hard working Americans have lost their jobs including many who are members of our YBA churches. But this "downturn" is an opportunity for Christian ministry. People are struggling to find hope and help. Where will they find that hope if we don't find share our hope in Christ? In a recent post on SBC.net, Dr. Morris Chapman made these comments:

...we must keep our ears tuned to the ministries God would have us undertake to witness to the power of God to answer prayer and shine light where there is darkness. Will Hall, vice president for news services at the Executive Committee, is a deacon and spiritual leader in his local

church. Last month, God gave the pastor of the church, the College Heights Baptist Church in Gallatin, Tennessee, an inspired idea to post a message on the sign in front of the church. The message asked people to text their prayer requests to a cell phone number. When the church listed the number on the sign, the phone was flooded with text messages from all ages of individuals requesting prayer. And they keep coming. The local television station did a newscast on it and even more made requests. I want to read one of the text messages which I believe is representative of millions of people who are outside the doors of our church.

"Can you please pray for me? And she gives her name. My 37-year-old son attempted to commit suicide last June. He lived for 12 hours on a machine and I had to make the decision to take him off life support. Now I feel like I have murdered my son. He left behind a daughter and a son. My mother passed away 9 weeks later. My father lives in my home now and is on hospice, suffering from congestive heart failure. My husband is looking at the possibility of closing his business due to the economy and health reasons. We have bills piling up. We have a home in a nearby town that we are trying to sell to pay off our debt. And in capital letters which means to shout or to cry out PLEASE PRAY!!"

God has given us a window of opportunity to point people to the true Savior, Jesus the Messiah. If we don't point them to Jesus, someone will point them in the wrong direction and the window of opportunity will be closed.

How we respond right now is critical. We can focus on ourselves or we can focus on the greatest task of all—glorifying God in all circumstances.
